Application Questions:

- *Please provide separate, typewritten answers to each of the following questions. Length may be one paragraph or longer but may not exceed one typewritten page for each question.*
 - *Answers to questions will be evaluated for content, thoroughness and how well they convey your activities and their importance to you.*
1. Discuss community service that you have performed, with particular focus on your involvement in St. Norbert Parish Community activities.
(Examples: Volunteering and participating in St. Norbert Parish activities such as Christian Services, Altar Serving, Youth Ministry, Jóvenes/Adolescentes Para Cristo, Ministerio Hispano, St. Norbertfest, St. Norbert Choir, Southwest Community Kitchen Outreach, SRE and other activities.)
 2. Discuss other extracurricular activities in which you have participated in your school or community.
(Examples: Participation in a team sport, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Associated Student Body, etc.)
 3. Discuss how your Catholic faith plays an active role in your life.

Essay:

- *The maximum length of the essay is 500 words.*
- *The essay must be typewritten, include your name at the top of the first page.*
- *Essay will be evaluated for content, creativity, clarity and grammar.*

Write a personal essay on why you want to go to college. In the essay, please tell us what your future plans are, as a Catholic man or woman, to become a school or community leader.
