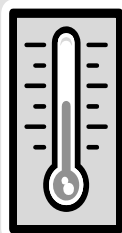


A PRAYER FOR PENTECOST

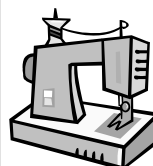

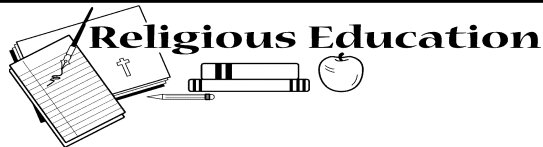

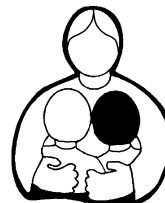

WONDERING WHY

Our newly confirmed youth and adults have been sealed with the gift with the Holy Spirit completing their Christian initiation. We believe that the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit which are first given in Baptism are strengthened in this sacrament. The designation of the gifts comes from Isaiah 11:2 and was intended as the sign by which the Messiah would be recognized. The word *Messiah* in Hebrew means "anointed one" and is translated into Greek as *Christos* or Christ. To be anointed is to be like Christ, to be Christian. Our confirmandi are anointed ones, signed on their foreheads with holy Chrism, and receiving the gifts of the Spirit – just like the Messiah, just like Jesus.

Probably at some time in our religious formation most of us memorized the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. Maybe we haven't thought much about them since that time. But they have been in us, planted at Baptism, strengthened in Confirmation and growing to maturity through lives of faith and prayer. Let's take this Pentecost Sunday and think about these gifts we have received from God and how they have come to fruition in our own lives.

Wisdom is sensing internally what is right, good and true. Sometimes in competition with the many voices of culture and society that call to us to live in ways that are not in the Spirit of God.

Knowledge is an intentional awareness of the teachings of our faith and of the wonders of creation and the desire to continue learning.

Understanding is the ability to stand in another's place, to see things from a different point of view, to be empathetic and compassionate.

Counsel is the gift of good judgment and the ability to help others find the right path, especially in times of doubt and confusion.

Courage is the ability to act when afraid, to speak prophetically about our faith, to stand up for what we believe.

Reverence or Piety is the desire to worship, to pray, to sing praise to God for all the good he has given to us, and to honor every person as each is made in the image of God.

Awe and Wonder in the Presence of the Lord is the realization that we are surrounded at all times by the loving presence of the Lord and finding Him present in nature, music, art, literature, liturgy, but most of all in one another.

On this Pentecost, the celebration of the Holy Spirit empowering the Church, perhaps we could each take a few minutes to ponder these seven gifts that we have each received. Reflect upon which ones have blossomed most fully in our lives and which ones need to be tended a bit more carefully, so that we can be God's anointed ones. And to give thanks to God for these gifts we have seen in others which have been shared with us in love, kindness, guidance and healing peace.

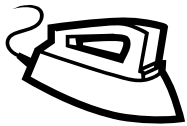

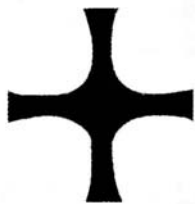
