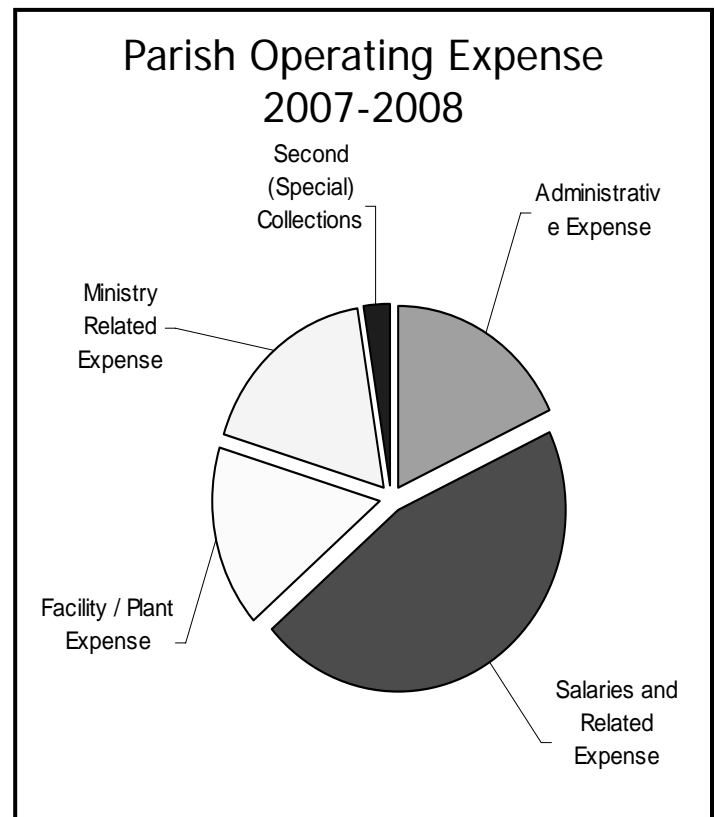
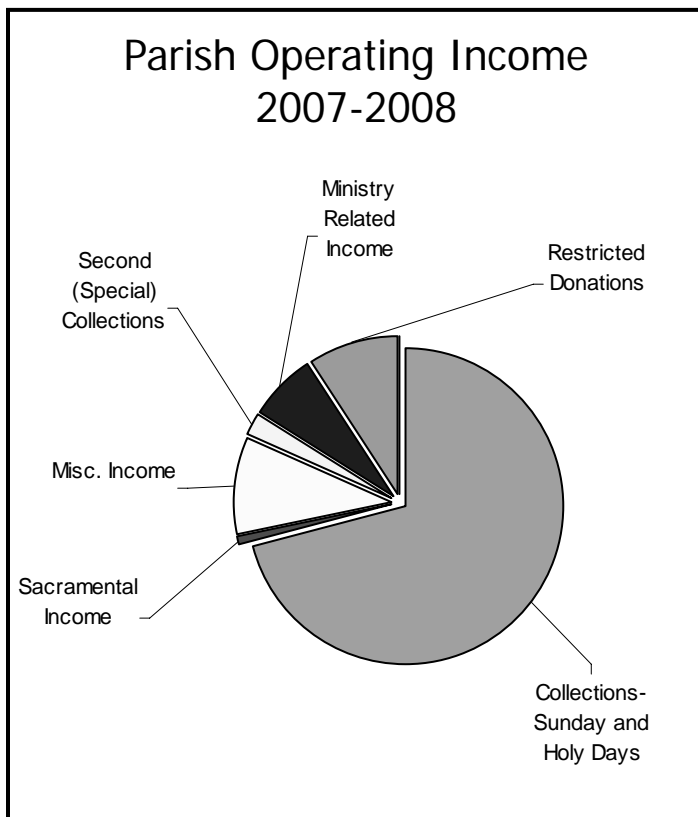


## THE PARISH BUDGET FOR 2007-2008

Hall. We will be discussing several important topics, including some new diocesan guidelines. **Please plan to attend either session.**



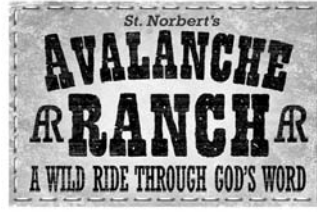

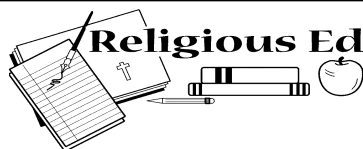

## WONDERING WHY



The king and priest Melchizedek might have been surprised to know that anyone would remember him nearly 4,000 years after his lifetime, but we hear his name in today's reading and also in the Eucharistic prayers of the Mass. No one knows much about this man, the only biographical data available is a short passage in

chapter 14 of Genesis. He appears again the Letter to the Hebrews in the New Testament, but then as a symbolic figure, a type or pre-figuring of Christ, the eternal high priest.

So, we might wonder who he was and why he was so important that we keep reminding ourselves of his story. The story in Genesis tells us that Melchizedek was the King of Salem. The word "salem" means peace. So Melchizedek was the king of peace. He comes to celebrate with Abraham after a battle, to celebrate not only the victory, but also the restoration of peace. "Salem" might also have referred to a place, possibly the area now called Jerusalem, a name which means the Peace of God.

Both Melchizedek and Abraham lived in a polytheistic society, a culture that believed in many gods, but both of these men had a particular connection to the God they called *El Shaddai*, which means "the One High God". Even though they did not yet know a name for him, they knew in their hearts the One they served. In celebration, this priest, Melchizedek makes an offering to the One High God, an offering of bread and wine. It is the first account in the scriptures of anyone offering these staples of life as a religious sacrifice.

Almost 2000 years later another King of Peace would offer bread and wine to God and then share it with his companions. He would use the words that St. Paul records in his letter to the Corinthians which we hear in our second reading today, "This is my body that is for you ... this cup is the new covenant in my blood ..." Our King of Peace, our High Priest, Jesus, takes the staples of human life and through them joins us to himself and to one another. We receive the living, eternal, risen presence of Jesus every time we receive communion. We may have learned as children that we receive his body, blood, soul and divinity. Certainly that is true, but we can take those words even further. When we receive Jesus in the Eucharistic bread and wine we also receive his hopes, dreams, emotions, struggles, disappointments, and above all his love. We receive the *complete* person of who Jesus is – who he is and will be forever.

And with Jesus, we are also in communion with his whole Church, which St. Paul refers to as the Body of Christ. We receive his body to become his body present in the world. As St. Augustine once wrote, "Say amen to who you are, become what you receive" – the Body of Christ.

## NEW BIBLE STUDY BEGINNING

The Hebrew Scriptures was the only Bible that Jesus ever read. As Christians it is important to understand the writings of our ancestors in faith in order to understand more fully the message proclaimed by Jesus. An Introduction to the Bible, focusing on the Old Testament writings will be offered on **Thursday evenings** from 7:30 to 9 p.m. beginning on **June 21**. We will meet in the Ministry Center Library. Topics in this 7-week course will be:

- June 21:** Introduction – background and history of the books of the Old Testament
- June 28:** Genesis – the creation stories
- July 5:** Genesis & Exodus – Patriarchs to Moses
- July 12:** Historical Books – A Nation Chosen by God
- July 19:** Prophets - Those who speak for God
- July 26:** After the Exile – Rebuilding nation and faith
- August 2:** Wisdom Literature and Apocalyptic Writings

Pope Benedict XVI has just published a book called *Jesus of Nazareth* in which the Holy Father reflects upon the person of Jesus and the meaning of the events of his ministry from his baptism until his transfiguration. This is a beautifully written and reverent book which can lead us to deeper faith and relationship with Jesus. Please join us on Wednesday evenings for a chapter by chapter group discussion of this book beginning on Wednesday evening, **June 20**, in the Ministry Center Library from 7:30 to 8:30 p.m. This book is readily available at most bookstores, discount stores, and on-line sites such as Amazon.com. Please bring your own copy, and read the Introduction and Chapter 1 prior to the first gathering.

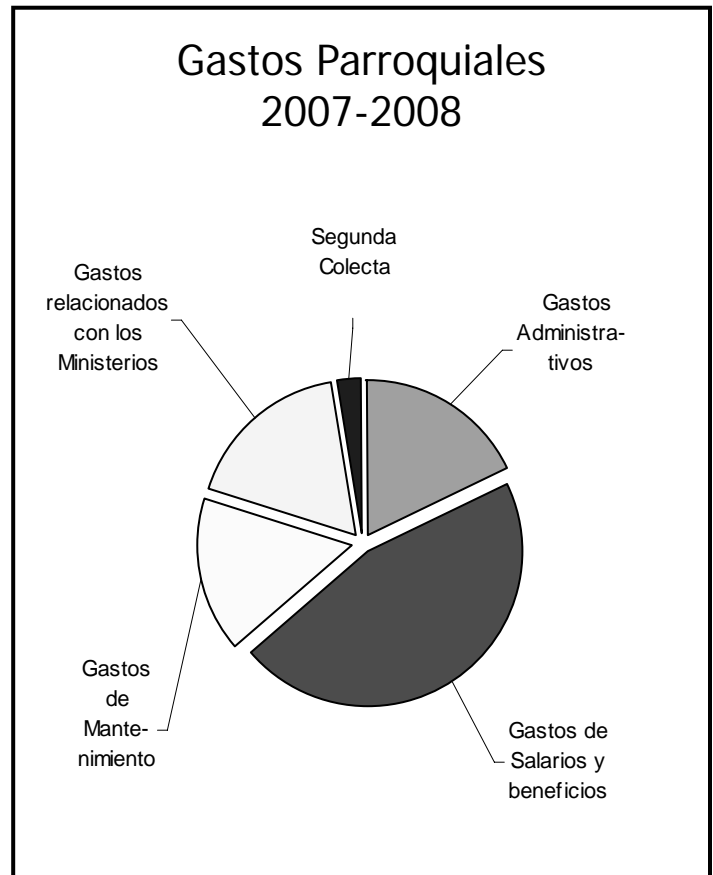
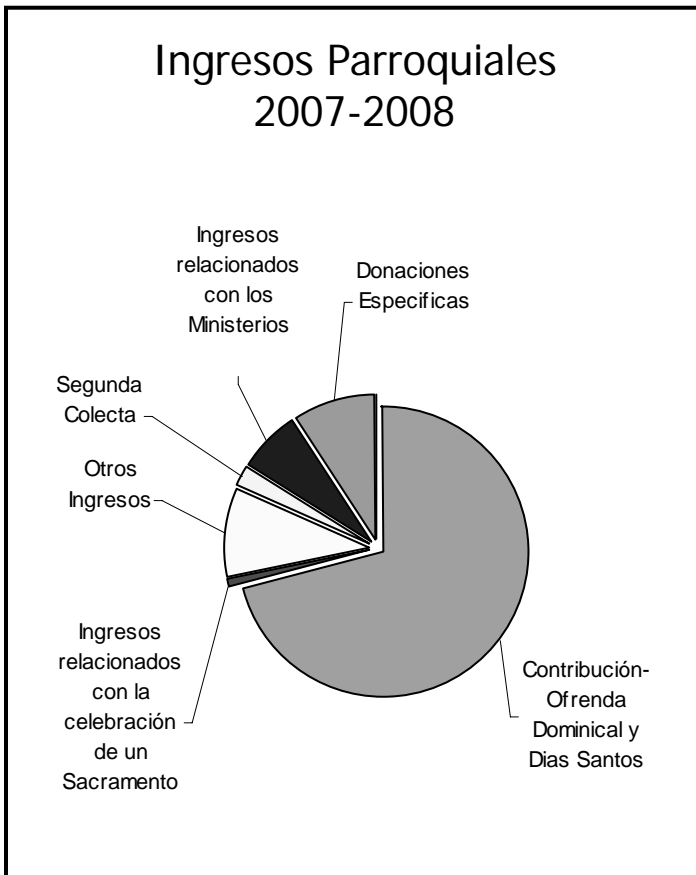

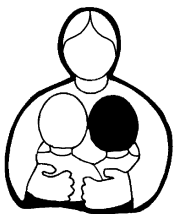

## Spiritual Adoption Birthdays Celebration!

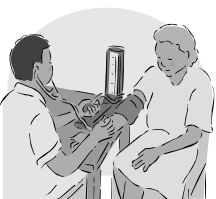

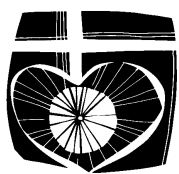

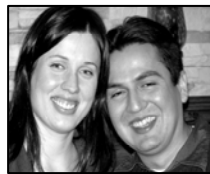
