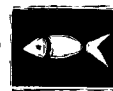


### Parish Lenten Penance Service Monday, March 22 at 7 p.m.

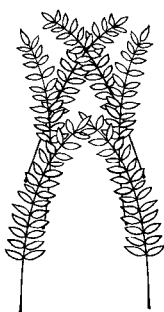

## School of Religious Education

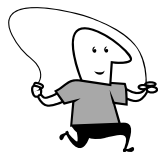
### Pre-School through 8th Grade

But, we're on a journey with totally different, unique and wonderful perspectives. Do we dare miss out another day wherein the Lord is trying to engage us with life, love, success, happiness, meaning, purpose, healing, freedom, peace?

We will have both morning sessions following the 8:30 Mass, and evening sessions at 7:30 p.m. Both will be followed by a time for refreshments and fellowship.

## WONDERING WHY

The traditional spiritual disciplines of the Lenten season are prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Perhaps it is worthwhile to reflect on why these practices enhance our spiritual life and awareness of the presence of God.

All relationships are built on communication. The more honest, open, and frequent the communication is, the healthier and stronger the relationship will be. Our communication with God comes through prayer. In prayer, we speak, we listen, we reflect on what God may be saying to us in the depths of our hearts and minds. Prayer can take many forms, but it is always a means of communication with God. For prayer to be fruitful, it must include silence for listening, reflecting, noticing how the Spirit of God is present and working through the events of our lives. Rather than giving God a list of what we want him to do, it may be helpful to reflect on our lives, our relationships, our challenges, our joys, even those things which make us uncomfortable or anxious, and find how God is already present and working to bring grace and conversion to ourselves and others. Lent may be a good time to try practicing a form of prayer that is a change from regular habits. We might return to traditional prayer forms of the Rosary or Stations of the Cross if those have fallen into disuse in our spiritual practices. Some may want to try a different kind of scriptural meditation, such as *Lectio Divina* when reading the Bible or an Ignatian meditation where one places oneself into the setting of a Biblical story and through one's imagination interacts with the situation and the people present. Maybe a Franciscan style of prayer focusing on the gifts of nature while taking a long walk or resting in a garden might be a new practice for some. Others might simply wish to be silent, resting in the awareness and assurance of God's eternal love.

Fasting certainly is a method of self-discipline, learning to control our appetites, which then helps to strengthen the spirit against sinful tendencies. But, there is another aspect to fasting that is sometimes overlooked. True fasting enables the third practice, almsgiving. We fast, we give up something, so that we have something to give. If we fast from that morning stop at Starbucks and instead give the money we would have spent to help the poor, our fasting has provided us with the means to help someone else, not just ourselves. If instead of watching television, we spend our time volunteering at a hospital, youth center, or helping someone learn to read, our fasting of time has given us time we thought we didn't have to better the life of someone else.

Almsgiving, the giving of money, time, talents and one's self, helps to free us from being self-absorbed and to focus on the needs of others. When we do so, our world opens to larger possibilities, greater awareness, and a more profound encounter with the living Christ whom we can come to know in new and deeper ways by recognizing his presence in other people. We have many opportunities to help those in need materially, emotionally, and spiritually. When we give of ourselves or our resources to make someone else's life better we participate in the mission of Jesus. This Lent our almsgiving might be accomplished in offering financial aid to earthquake victims, reading to children at our local library, volunteering at a homework help center, increasing our weekly donation to our parish, or even spending more time with our own children and less time viewing the Internet or television. As we practice that first discipline of Lent, deeper prayer, God will surely suggest to us appropriate opportunities for fasting and almsgiving. In responding, we help Jesus in building the Kingdom of God.

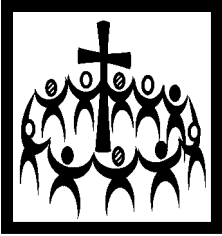
