Dear Parents,


Short Week = Short Newsletter. I hope all of you had a great time at the Octoberfest.

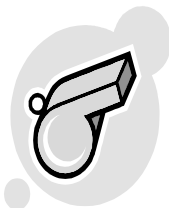
