Dear Parents,

When we do things on regular basis they become routine, you forget that not everyone knows what you are doing or how things are done. One such case is the "Jeans for Mary." "Jeans for Mary" is a student community service project that occurs during the month of October. Students are allowed to wear long blue jeans and a spirit shirt or uniform polo shirt and are charged \$.50 for the privilege. ## BUNDLE SUNDAY

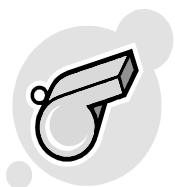


St. Vincent de Paul Society will have a big truck parked on our premises to collect all donations on **Sunday, October 15**. The truck will be staffed by volunteer
