## Attention Parents of Preschoolers!

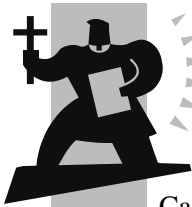
St. Norbert Parish School will hold its kindergarten assessments tomorrow, February 10. If you have an incoming kindergartener, please call the school office to schedule your appointment.
